By this petition, filed under the provisions of Section 439 of the Cr.P.C, the petitioner seeks the concession of regular bail, upon FIR no.155, dated 09.06.2012, having been registered at Police Station Patti, District Tarn Taran, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 323, 324, 325, 326, 302, 148 and 149 of the IPC.
