Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of impugned order dated 22.02.2019 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Principal Judge, Family Court, Jind, whereby on an application filed by respondent No.1-wife under Section 125 Cr.PC for maintenance, the petitioner-husband has been directed to pay the interim maintenance allowance of Rs.6,000/- per month to her from the date of filing of the petition till its final disposal.

Vide order dated January 08, 2020 passed by this Court, on joint request of learned counsel for the petitioner and respondent No.2, the matter

was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, where the parties were directed to appear on 20.01.2020.

As per the report dated 06.02.2020 received from the Mediator, mediation is successful and the matter has been compromised between the parties vide settlement agreement dated 06.02.2020.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous.

However, the settlement agreement dated 06.02.2020 be made part of the record and the parties shall adhere to its terms and conditions in its letter and spirit.

It has been pointed out that in compliance of order dated 08.04.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already deposited a bank draft of Rs.10,000/- as litigation expenses in favour of respondent No.1 with the Registry.

The petitioner is directed to get the said bank draft re-validated and to hand over the same to respondent No.1 by way of registered post within a period of one month from today.
