AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

In compliance with the order passed by this Court on 10.07.2020 in CRM-M No.16575 of 2020, counsel for the State has placed on record the medico-legal reports of complainant-Vishal.

It is the contention of learned counsel for the petitioners that as far as Sunil @ Shanga and Naveen are concerned, the allegations against them are that they caught hold of Vishal firmly, when the other two co-accused had given him beating. He contends that apart from this role, there is no other role attributed to them. Petitioners are in custody since 24.05.2020 and till date, no challan has been filed. Assertion has been made that the petitioners be granted the concession of bail.

Counsel for the Union Territory of Chandigarh could not dispute the contention of the counsel for the petitioners.

In the light of the allegations against the petitioners and keeping in view the fact that the petitioners are in custody for almost two months, these petitions are allowed.

Petitioners are directed to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Chandigarh.

Any observations made hereinabove are for the purpose of disposal of the present petitions alone and shall have no bearing on the merit of the case during the trial in any manner.
