The petitioner was arrested on 20.07.2019. Investigation

against him has since been completed and challan submitted. It further transpires that the co-accused Rinku has already been granted regular bail by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M No.12358 of 2020 on 19.06.2020. As such, further detention of the petitioner for an indefinite period at this stage is not warranted.

[3]. In such circumstances and considering the long detention undergone by the petitioner, he is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
