1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of pandemic Covid-19.
2. Prayer in the writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for the issuance of a writ of Certiorari for quashing notices Annexure P/1 and P/2 dated 15.05.2020 and 22.05.2020 and further for the issuance of a writ of Mandamus for directing the respondents to consider the petitioner eligible for the post in question as also to allow her to participate in the selection process by applying for the post in question.
3. Learned DAG, Haryana, states that the writ petition has become infructuous in view of the date for applying for the post in question having been extended upto 05.07.2020, vide notice dated 26.06.2020.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in the circumstances, he does not press the writ petition any further and the same may be disposed of as having become infructuous.
