Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.74 dated 06.06.2020, registered at Police Station Chabbewal, District Hoshiarpur, under Sections 308, 323, 506 and 34 IPC

On 26.06.2020, this Court passed the following order :-

“Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.74 dated 06.06.2020, registered at Police Station Chabbewal, District Hoshiarpur, under Sections 308, 323, 506 and 34 IPC. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that two injuries i.e. danda blows on the left shoulder and left back of Inderjeet Singh, have been attributed to the petitioner. The main injury has been attributed to Bhupinder Singh, who stands arrested.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Ajay Pal Singh Gill, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State, and submits that two injuries attributed to Bhupinder Singh are dangerous to life and he is in custody. However, the injuries attributed to the petitioner are simple in nature.

Adjourned to 14.09.2020.

Meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation and if she is sought to be arrested, she shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions as envisaged in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. ”.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 26.06.2020 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI-Jarnail Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and the challan has also been presented and that she is not required for any further investigation.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 26.06.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
