Today, at the very outset, the petitioner who is appearing in person has submitted that the Hon'ble Supreme Court in its recent guidelines issued on 13.8.2016 in writ petition (Civil) No.13029 of 1982 titled as MC Mehta Vs. Union of India and Ors. has permitted registration of vehicles which had been purchased prior to 31.3.2020 and that in view of the said position the petitioner may be permitted to withdraw this petition so as to pursue the same with the authorities concerned for registration of her vehicle which had been purchased in December, 2019.
