The present contempt petition is filed for having wilfully disobeyed the order dated 2.9.2019 (Annexure P-7).

Reply has been filed. Para No.25 of the same reads as under:-

“The execution of warrants of possession of 43 kanal 01 marla land out of land in question had already been made on the spot and possession of only 2 kanal 00 marla land is still under the shadow of Court order as per facts stated above. Since the Gram Panchayat Damla had already received the possession of suit land and 223 cows on the spot, so the averment made by the petitioner in has no legal sanctity.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the contents of para No.25 of the reply.

In view of the above, this Court finds that the order has been duly complied with except for 2 kanals of land, which is a subject matter of civil dispute.

In view of the same, the contempt petition is dismissed as infructuous.

Rule issued against the respondent(s) is discharged.
