Present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.62 dated 05.06.2020, under Sections 420, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Rampura, District Bathinda.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Manjinder Singh, has submitted that in pursuance of order dated 25.06.2020, petitioner has already joined the investigation and is no longer required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 25.06.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
