The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in the present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the pension to the petitioner being the victim of emergency as per government notification dated 16.04.2018.

Learned State counsel submits that the case of the petitioner has been considered by the authority and the pension, which was being disbursed to the petitioner, has been restored back. He further states that he has the instructions to state that the arrears of pension for the period it was stopped is also being calculated and the outstanding arrears would be

released to the petitioner within one month from today.

In view of the statement so made by learned State counsel, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed as such.
