The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.193 dated 28.03.2020 registered under Sections 406, 420, 498-A, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Sadar Thanesar, District Kurukshetra.

The operative part of the order dated 25.06.2020, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioners, is reproduced as under:-

“...Learned counsel for the petitioners inter alia contends that false and fabricated allegations have been levelled against the petitioner, who are parents-in-law of the complainant. He further submits that the allegation that 3 kanal 6 marlas of land, which was in the name of deceased husband of the complainant, was fraudulently transferred in the name of petitioner No.1, was found to be untrue during an inquiry by the police. In fact, the land in question already stood transferred in the name of the

complainant and her son. He also submits that the petitioners are willing to join investigation and whatever istridhan/dowry articles, which are alleged to be in their custody, would be returned to the complainant for which, their custodial interrogation may not be necessary in the given circumstances.

Notice of motion....”

Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 25.06.2020, the petitioners have appeared before the Investigating Officer and have joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Ravinder Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioners are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 25.06.2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
