This is a petition for regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioner, who was arrested on 02.08.2019, in case FIR No.194 dated 31.07.2019, under Sections 324, 307 and 34 of the IPC (Sections 148 and 149 deleted) and Sections 25/54/59 of the Arms Act (added later on), registered at Police Station Israna, District Panipat.

[2]. It transpires that the actual victim in the alleged occurrence, namely, Sonu had turned hostile and did not give any incriminating statement against any culprit.

[3]. The complainant, namely, Anuj appears to have amicably compromised the dispute with the accused persons.

[4]. In the given circumstances, without commenting on the merits of the case at this stage, but considering the long detention undergone by the petitioner and also the fact that the trial is likely to take its considerable time to complete due to ongoing Covid-19 Pandemic, he is permitted to be

released on bail subject to the appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
