This is an application under Section 482 Cr.P.C for making addition of offence under Section 326 IPC in the head note, body of the main petition and prayer clause of the petition for anticipatory bail.

For the reasons stated in the application, application is allowed subject to all just exceptions.

Registry is directed to make necessary corrections in the head note, body of the main petition and prayer clause of petition for anticipatory bail.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.41 dated 10.03.2020 registered under Sections 307/34 IPC (Section 326 IPC was added later on) and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act at Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 25.6.2020 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation. This fact is not disputed by the counsel for the State as well.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Kishan Singh states that the petitioner is no longer required for further interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 25.6.2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
