On account of outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic, the matter is taken up through video conferencing.

Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to provide security and safety to the petitioners as respondent No.4 at the instance of private respondents is harassing and threatening them.

Learned counsel for the State has placed on record the reply by Deputy Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 by way of an affidavit wherein it is clearly stated that there is no apprehension of threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners. The petitioners are neither required by the police in connection with any case nor the police has ever raided the house of the petitioners as alleged.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, in the circumstances, submits that in view of the aforementioned he would not press the instant petition.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
