Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.31 dated 02.03.2020 registered under Section 420 and 34 IPC and Section 24 of the Immigration Act, at Police Station Sadar Ludhiana, District Ludhiana

Vide order dated 26.06.2020, this Court had granted interim bail to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 26.06.2020 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI-Paramjeet Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not

required for any further investigation.
