Case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner wants that State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, Punjab (respondent No.2) be restrained from hearing the proceedings in Execution Application Nos.EA/217/17, 97/18, 181/18, 180/18, 443/18, 501/18, 502/18, 434/18, 435/18, 03/19, 07/19, 605/19, 15/19, 20/19, 32/19, 33/19, 86/19, 149/19, 155/19, 156/19, 241/19, 272/19, 278/19, 353/19, 222/19, 320/19, 338/19, 347/19, 359/19, 360/19, 403/19, 404/19, 405/19, 408/19, 409/19, 419/19, 437/19, 450/19, 451/19, 469/19, 482/19, 561/19, 562/19, 563/19, 19/20, 20/20, 21/20, 50/20, 30/20, 67/20 and 68/20, on 03.07.2020 due to widespread of Covid-19 Novel Corona Virus

across the country, inasmuch as, in this sever out-break of Covid 19

pandemic, the petitioner and his advocate may come in contact with other persons, resulting in a serious health hazard. The medical experts have discarded gatherings in terms of various notices and advertisements issued by the Central and State Governments.

Learned counsel has fairly agreed to appear before the State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, Punjab, in all the aforesaid execution applications on 17.08.2020, inasmuch as, it appears that by that time, the effect of Covid-19 Novel Corona would dilute.

In view of above, instant petition stands disposed of with direction to the petitioner to appear before State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, Punjab on 17.08.2020., who is advised to adjourn all the matters of the petitioner from 03.07.2020 to 17.08.2020.
