Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.53 dated 06.06.2015, under Sections 294, 447, 511, 379, 506 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Mehna, District Moga on the basis of compromise dated 12.11.2016 (Annexure P-2) and consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Twice the opportunity was granted to the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording the statements in support of the compromise.

As per the report, on both the occasions, the parties did not appear for recording their statements.

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the instant petition.
