

absence of challenge to said order, the writ petition is not maintainable.

6. Faced with the aforementioned position, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to file fresh writ petition to challenge order dated 22.04.2020 passed by respondent No.2 and also prays for interim protection in the meantime.

7. Learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab states that he has no objection to the limited prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner.

8. In the circumstances, the writ petition is permitted to be withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for. However, action on the basis of order dated 22.04.2020 passed by respondent No.2 as well as Annexure P-8 dated 22.06.2020 would be kept in abeyance for a period of two weeks from today. Further action on the impugned order would be subject to the orders if any, to be passed by the Court in the eventuality of the petitioner invoking the jurisdiction of a court of law within the aforementioned period of time. Writ petition disposed of with the aforementioned directions
