1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.78 dated 07.04.2020, registered under Sections 323/324/148/149 and (326 added later on) IPC, at Police Station Sadar Patti, District Tarn Taran.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 06.07.2020, the petitioner joined investigation, fully cooperated in the investigation, was released on ad interim pre arrest bail and that his custodial interrogation is not required.
4. Learned DAG, Punjab on instructions from ASI Hardial Singh, confirms that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 06.07.2020, the petitioner joined investigation, cooperated in the investigation and was released on ad-interim pre-arrest bail and further that his custodial interrogation is not required.

5. In view of the position as noted above, order dated 06.07.2020, passed by this Court, is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions enumerated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

6. Petition stands disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
