The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of arrest in FIR No. 191 dated 28.05.2020 under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 4 & 5 of the Prize Chits and Money Circulation Schemes (Banning) Act, 1978 registered at Police Station City Sangrur, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is falsely implicated in the present case and that on the direction of this Court, has joined the investigation. It is also contended that nothing is to be recovered from him.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sukhwinder Singh, submits that petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for the custodial interrogation.

In view of the facts that the petitioner has joined the investigation

and is not required for custodial interrogation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 10.07.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i) (ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
