This is an application (CRM-2171-2020) that has been filed seeking to withdraw the petition i.e. CRM-M-16187 of 2019, which is now listed for 24.02.2020 on the basis that a compromise has been effected between the parties.

The petitioner herein had filed the said petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuing the necessary direction to the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar to register an FIR on the basis of complaint dated 15.01.2018, however, subsequent to the filing of the petition, the instant misc. application has been filed by the petitioner, which is supported by an affidavit, submitting that the matter has been compromised between the parties and she does not want to pursue the petition, in view of the compromise dated 05.08.2019 and seeks to withdraw the same.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed. Petition bearing CRM-M-16187 of 2019 is taken up for hearing today and the same is dismissed as withdrawn.
