During the course of hearing, it is not disputed that the certified copy of the order dated 06.03.2020 passed in CWP-6387-2020 was sent by petitioner through registered post on 19.03.2020, therefore, the period of three months for deciding the legal notice cannot be construed to be over in the light of prevailing situation. It is needless to observe that the country continues to be in the throes of global pandemic, namely, COVID-19 and the State Government & District Administration have imposed various restrictions to curtail its spread.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press this petition at this stage and wishes to withdraw the same.
