This is the second petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.42 dated 22.3.2019 under Sections 307/506/148/149/120-B IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran. The earlier petition was dismissed on 2.7.2020.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the new ground for the anticipatory bail is that in the meantime, the parties were having talks of compromise, which have finally been arrived at between them.

Counsel for the petitioner has relied upon compromise Annexure P-2 and the affidavit of the injured/victim Annexures P-3 and P-4.

Learned State counsel, on telephonic instructions of the Investigating Officer, has not disputed the aforesaid fact.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is granted the anticipatory bail, subject to the conditions as envisaged in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

However, it will be open for the Investigating Officer to call upon the petitioner for any investigation, if it is so required, by giving a written notice.
