This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.07 dated 23.01.2020, under Sections 377/323/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station, Sadar, Moga, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that marriage of the petitioner was solemnized with the complainant in the year 2002. An FIR No.145 dated 05.12.2016, under Sections 498-A/34 IPC was got registered at Police Station, Kotkapura by the complainant against the petitioner and other family members. However, during investigation, the said FIR was cancelled and the cancellation report was accepted by the Court vide order dated 10.03.2017.

As per custody certificate, petitioner is in custody for the last

Keeping in view that the period of incarceration of the petitioner and the fact that the trial will take some time for its conclusion, this Court feels that no purpose will be served by detaining the petitioner any longer. Accordingly, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing of bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Moga.
