The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No.154 dated 10.07.2019 registered under Sections 295, 452, 427, 323, 304 (added lateron), 148, 149, 34 IPC, 1860 (Section 302 IPC deleted) at Police Station Islamabad, District Amritsar.

It is contended by counsel for the petitioner that the case against the petitioner is concocted. Even as per the story of the prosecution, no injury is attributed to the petitioner. He is only alleged to be present on the scene of occurrence empty handed. The petitioner is in custody since 25.02.2020. The co-accused of the petitioner, who was alleged to be armed with a daang, has already been released on bail by this Court. The challan has been presented. The petitioner is not required for any investigation purposes.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Randhir Singh Thind, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on

behalf of the State.

Learned State Counsel, being instructed by SI Manjeet Singh, has submitted that the name of the petitioner has specifically been mentioned in the FIR. However, it is not disputed that the petitioner is alleged to be present empty handed and that the co-accused who was alleged to be armed with daang has already been granted bail.

In view of the above, but without commenting upon merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. It is ordered that the petitioner be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/ sureties to the satisfaction of the trial Court/ Duty Magistrate.
