Hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing at length, has submitted that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition which is not considered appropriate particularly when the arguments have been heard at length. Hence, the prayer for withdrawal of the petition is declined.

The petitioner prays for grant of bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.104, dated 27.06.2019, registered under Section 22/29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Sadar Sangrur, District Sangrur.

As per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner was allegedly found in conscious possession of 1050 Clovidol 100 SR tablets containing Tramadol Hydrochloride salt. As per the report of Forensic Science Laboratory, the total weight of the tablets comes to 433.65 grams. The quantity of the contraband allegedly recovered from the petitioner is of commercial category.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and in view of the provisions of Section 37 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, this court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
