The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No.140, dated 24.5.2020 under Sections 306 and 34 IPC registered at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to the order dated 26.6.2020 passed by this Court, petitioners who are the mother-in-law and married sister-in-law of the deceased have joined the investigation. This fact is not disputed by the counsel for the State as well.

Learned State counsel has conceded that no recovery is to be made from either of the petitioners.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 26.6.2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
