This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. raising a two fold prayer; (i) directions are sought to official respondents No. 2 and 3 to ensure protection of life and liberty of the petitioner by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of private respondents No. 4 to 6; (ii) a prayer is for directing official respondents to conduct a free and fair investigation and to arrest the private respondents in case FIR No.0111 dated 20.05.2020 under Sections 447, 511, 380, 427 and 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Canal Colony, Bathinda.

Counsel having argued the matter at length and sensing that this Court was not willing to intervene seeks withdrawal of the petition with liberty to the petitioner to avail of her alternate remedies as may be available in accordance with law.
