This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C.raising a two fold prayer i.e.(i) for issuance of directions to official respondents No.2 and 3 to register FIR against private respondents No.5 to 7; (ii) for issuance of directions to respondent No.3 to decide the representation dated 11.12.2019 (Annexure P-2) and 04.05.2020 (Annexure P-3) that has been filed by the petitioner and his father.

Having heard counsel for the petitioner at length and having perused the pleadings on record, this Court is of the considered view that no intervention in the instant petition is called for.

The directions sought for registration of an FIR against private respondents is on the assertion that they have forcibly cut and taken away the paddy crop from the land of the petitioner. In para 6 of the petition it has been averred that a suit for permanent injunction already stands filed

by the opposite party and in which the present petitioner stand arrayed as a party defendant. Civil proceedings as such are already pending between the parties.

As regards deciding the representations at Annexures P-2 and P-3 are concerned a perusal of the representations would reveal that essentially the prayer raised is the one that has already been afore-noticed and dealt with by this Court.

No interference is called for.

Petition is disposed of.

It would be open for the petitioner however to avail of any other alternate remedy that may be available in accordance with law as also to pursue and oppose the civil proceedings that already has been initiated by the private respondents.

Disposed of.
