HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The case has been taken up by way of Video Conference as per instructions in view of COVID-19 pandemic.

The grievance of petitioners is that they have taken a shop on rent from one Ajit Singh Jheeta who is an NRI. They are in occupation of said shop since 2008 and even continuously paying the rent to son of Ajit Singh Jheeta.

It is alleged that respondents No. 5 and 6 who are property dealers in connivance with respondents No. 7 to 9 are interfering into peaceful possession of petitioners though, no case has been filed against petitioners by their landlord. Petitioners instituted a suit for injunction against respondents No. 5 and 6 on 27.5.2020 and an interim order was passed in favour of petitioners. It is alleged that respondents No. 5 to 9 are threatening the petitioners to withdraw the case. They even attempted to demolish the property on the intervening night of 9/10.6.2020 and threatened to kill petitioners. Petitioners apprehend danger to their lives at the hands of said respondents. They have submitted representations to respondents No. 3 and 4 dated 11.6.2020 and 10.6.2020 (Annexure P-6 and Annexure P-7), but no action has been taken thereon. Infact, private respondents have been continuously giving threat to lives of petitioners.

Without commenting anything on the merits of case and without going into veracity of facts stated in the petition, this petition is

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disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 3 Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Jalandhar to look into representations dated 11.6.2020 and 10.6.2020 (Annexure-P-6 and Annexure-P-7) submitted by petitioners and take such action as may be warranted in law.
