The petitioners claim to be married. The 1st petitioner is aged 20-1/2 years, as per her claim. She states that her Date of Birth is 26.07.1999 but has no evidence in proof thereof. The 2nd petitioner, her husband, is aged about 27 years and he produced his Aadhar Card in proof of his Date of Birth. By way of this Criminal Writ Petition, they sought protection of their lives and liberty from the unofficial respondents, the family members of the 1st petitioner, who were not inclined to accept their relationship.

By order dated 26.06.2020, this Court granted an interim direction requiring the Superintendent of Police, District Kaithal, to take

appropriate action upon the petitioners' representation dated 24.06.2020

and extend adequate protection to their lives and liberty, if necessary. Despite service being completed, the family members of the 1st petitioner did not choose to enter appearance before this Court. While so, Mr. S.K. Bhoria learned counsel for the petitioners, would state that the petitioners are now living together peacefully and do not face any threat to their lives and liberty.

In that view of the matter, the petition is disposed of as infructuous leaving it open to the petitioners to seek protection in future, if warranted, by way of separate proceedings.

In consequence, interim order dated 26.06.2020 shall stand vacated.
