[5]. In view of the above, the Petitioner/Juvenile is ordered to be released on bail, subject to the appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned. But, two sureties have to be furnished, one of whom should be his own father, who shall also take responsibility for ensuring that the petitioner's conduct, while on bail, remains proper and peaceful.
