The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.62 dated 24.04.2020 registered under Sections 323, 341, 506, 379-B IPC at Police Station Jodhewal, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana.

On 29.06.2020, following order was passed:-

“Case is being taken up for hearing through video

conferencing.

Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.62 dated 24.04.2020, registered at Police Station Jodhewal, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana, under Sections 323, 341, 506 and 379-B IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is a delay of 09 days in lodging the FIR and no specific injury has been attributed to the petitioner. No weapon has been used by the petitioner at any stage and, therefore, no offence under Section 379-B IPC is made out.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Ajay Pal Singh Gill, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and admits the fact that no specific injury has been attributed to the petitioner. However, he states that there was earlier litigation pending between the brother of complainant and the petitioner.

Adjourned to 08.09.2020.

Meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation and if he is sought to be arrested, he shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions as envisaged in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Raj Kumar states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation of the case.

In view of above, order dated 29.06.2020 is made absolute. However, petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide

by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
