Prayer in this application filed under Section 151 CPC is for exemption from filing the prescribed court fee, advocate welfare stamp/fee etc.

Prayer for exemption of court fee on account of COVID-19 is accepted with the condition that the petitioner shall deposit the required court fee within a period of one month when the situation becomes normal from the COVID-19 effect.

Application stands disposed of.

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.160 dated 01.09.2018

District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that on 16.12.2019, petitioner could not appear before the trial court as another FIR No.237 dated 06.10.2019 under Sections 452, 323, 506, 34 IPC, Police Station Canal Colony, District Bathinda, was registered against him. Though vide order dated December 16, 2019 passed in **CRM-M-47926-2019(Amandeep Versus State of Punjab)**, arrest of the petitioner was stayed by this Court, however, for non-appearance before the trial court on 16.12.2019, learned Additional Sessions Judge, Bathinda has cancelled the bail bonds and forfeited the surety bonds to the State and non-bailable warrants were issued to the petitioner and he was arrested on 07.02.2020. He states that the petitioner is ready to appear before the trial court with an undertaking that he shall continue to appear before the trial court regularly.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Mr. V.G. Jauhar, Sr. D.A.G., Punjab, appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Heard.

In case, petitioner appears before the trial court within a period of 15 days from today, he shall be admitted on bail, subject to his furnishing fresh bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
