The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.328 dated 30.08.2019, under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 201 IPC (Section 201 was added lateron), registered at Police Station Hisar Civil Lines, District Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner, who was working as an Assistant Scientist in the Haryana Space Application Centre, is accused of allegedly issuing work orders on the basis of fake documents. It was alleged that the petitioner had received a sum of ₹2 lacs for preparing the documents. He, however, contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case and the petitioner had an unblemished service record.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Balwant Singh states that the challan has been filed but charges are yet to be framed.

Heard through video conferencing.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner is in custody for almost six months, Covid 19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
