Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if the present petition is taken up by the respondents as a representation on behalf of the petitioner and a conscious decision is taken thereon.

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that the respondent would definitely take a decision qua the claim of the petitioner by treating the present petition as a representation of the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of by directing the respondent to take a conscious decision on the claims of the petitioner by treating the present petition as a representation on behalf of the petitioner. The said decision shall be taken by the respondent within a period of three months from today.

It is further ordered that if any amount is payable to the petitioner as per the conscious decision, which is to be taken by the respondent, then the said payment would be made to the petitioner within a period of next two months from the date of the conscious decision. However, if the petitioner is not found entitled to any amount by the respondent, then the respondent shall communicate to the petitioner by a written order in this regard; within a period of two months from the date of conscious decision.
