**(PROCEEDINGS THROUGH V.C.)**

**AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASHI, J. (ORAL)**

Learned senior counsel for the respondents informs the Court that in CWP No.32600 of 2018, where the present contempt petition has been filed in non-compliance of the order dated 16.10.2019, a review petition has been preferred i.e. RA-CW-167 of 2020, which had come up for hearing on 13.08.2020, in which notice of motion has been issued along with an application preferred and *status quo* has been ordered to be maintained till the next date of hearing. He on the basis of the said interim order, which has been passed in the presence of the counsel for the petitioner herein, states that the present contempt petition, for now, has been rendered infructuous.

In the light of the above order dated 13.08.2020 passed in RA-CW-167 of 2020, the present contempt petition at this stage has been rendered infructuous.

Disposed of as such.

Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioner to file a fresh contempt petition in case the cause of action survives after the decision of the review application.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged for now.
