By way of this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in relation to FIR No.257 dated 22.12.2018 on the file of Police Station City South, District Moga, registered under Sections 323, 324, 148 and 149 IPC (Section 307 IPC added later on).

The petitioner was not shown as an accused in this FIR initially but was implicated in the offence by the named accused.

Mr. Amar Ashok Pathak, learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab, would inform this Court that as the petitioner was absconding, a non-bailable warrant was issued against him leading to proclamation proceedings being initiated under Section 82 Cr.P.C and the next date fixed in that regard is 18.9.2020.

Upon being apprised of this development, Mr. Manpreet Singh, learned counsel for the petitioner, seeks leave to withdraw this petition reserving liberty to the petitioner to take recourse to appropriate remedies available to him in accordance with law.

Leave granted.

The petition is accordingly dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforestated.
