It has been pointed out by learned counsel for the petitioner that Gurwinder Singh son of petitioner-Sarabjit Singh has been taken into custody by the Officer-in-Charge, Police Station, Sadar Ferozepur.

Mr. J.P.Ratra, DAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

It has been stated by learned State counsel that on receipt of the advance copy of the petition he has verified from SI Jaswant Singh, Officer-in-Charge, Police Station, Sadar Ferozepur who informed that Gurwinder Singh was called to Police Station on 24.6.2020 in an enquiry pertaining to FIR No. 117 dated 24.6.2020 which has been registered against unknown persons at Police Station Sadar Ferozepur. After recording the statements of Gurwinder Singh and others, Gurwinder Singh left the Police Station and is presently not confined in the Police Station.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner has

stated that the present petition be disposed with liberty to file the fresh one in the event, the assertion as pointed out by learned State counsel is found to be not true and the detenue is still in custody.
