The petition has been taken for hearing through video conference due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that respondents are going to construct a by-lane in the property of the petitioner so as to provide access to the petrol pump, which is being installed by respondent No. 4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no show cause notice whatsoever has been given to the petitioner seeking his objections but the respondents are going ahead for providing the access to the proposed petrol pump of respondent No. 4 by constructing a by-lane though, there is already a building constructed at the proposed by-lane, owned by the petitioner. The prayer of the petitioner is that the construction of the said by-lane is also contrary to the policy issued by respondents No. 1 to 3.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the grievance, which has been raised in the present writ petition, petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 27.05.2020 (Annexure P-1) to

authority and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No. 2 to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Puneet Kaur Sekhon, Advocate, who has also joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-UOI and raises no objection for passing appropriate order on the representation of the petitioner dated 27.05.2020 (Annexure P-1) in a time bound manner.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and the claim being made by the petitioner, respondent No. 2 is directed to decide the representation dated 27.05.2020 (Annexure P-1) by passing a speaking order within a period of one month from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

Writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
