Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a writ of *habeas corpus* for releasing Roopa, daughter of the petitioner from the illegal custody of respondents No.4 to 11.

In pursuance of order dated 25.6.2020, the Superintendent of Police, Sonipat has filed his affidavit. It is stated in the affidavit that Roopa was produced before the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sonipat on 27.6.2020, wherein she has recorded her statement that she has left the home on 28.5.2020 and has performed marriage with Badal and is residing in village Manakpur with him of her own. Along with the statement, the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sonipat has given a certificate that statement of Roopa was recorded in camera. Even the statement of Roopa was also recorded in the presence of DPO, Sonipat wherein he has made a similar statement. Therefore, it is stated in the affidavit of SHO, Sonipat that Roopa is residing with Badal of her own free will and she is not in illegal confinement.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is facing threats from the private respondents.

Since there is no representation attached with the petition, this petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to approach the Superintendent of Police, Sonipat by moving a complaint, if they have any threat to their lives and liberty.
