The petitioner is one of the accused in FIR No. 109 dated 29.02.2020 on the file of Police Station Rania, District Sirsa, registered under Sections 323, 324, 326, 341, 506 and 34 IPC. By way of this petition, he seeks grant of regular bail.

The petitioner has been in custody since 01.05.2020. It appears that cross-cases were registered by two factions but thereafter, a compromise was effected between them. This compromise was reduced to writing on 23.06.2020 as a Panchayati Compromise. In terms thereof, both sides agreed that they did not want to continue with their respective cross-cases.

Mr. C.S. Jattana, learned counsel for the complainant in FIR

No. 109 dated 29.02.2020, would confirm this and states that he has no objection to the petitioner being granted relief.

In the light of the compromise effected by and between the parties, the fate of the main case itself stands settled. That being so, the petitioner would be entitled to regular bail, subject to conditions.

The petition is accordingly allowed directing the release of the petitioner on regular bail in FIR No. 109 dated 29.02.2020 on the file of Police Station Rania, District Sirsa, upon his furnishing a personal bond for a sum of Rs. 20,000/- along with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the Illaqa/Duty Magistrate concerned. Further, the petitioner shall not cause any inducement, threat or promise to any person concerned with the case.
