The petitioner seeks grant of concession of regular bail in case bearing FIR No.22 dated 13.02.2020 under Sections 323, 365, 376-D, 506 IPC and Section 67 of the Information Technology (Amendment) Act, 2008, registered at Women Police Station, District Sonapat.

The victim (prosecutrix) has specifically levelled the allegations in the FIR that accused Nitin and Sahil, after having kidnapped her, had committed rape upon her and also made her obscene video and that their friend Rakesh i.e. the present petitioner, had issued her threats to viral her video and on this pretext, he had been insisting the prosecutrix to meet him.

The FIR in this case was registered on 13.02.2020. The petitioner was arrested on 14.02.2020. The statements of the prosecutrix and other witnesses are yet to be recorded.

Taking into consideration that the allegations against the petitioner are serious in nature, no case is made out to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Hence, the present petition is dismissed.
