Case is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C.
for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.79 dated 19.08.2019 registered
under Section 306 IPC, 1860, at Police Station GRP Hisar, District Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner was
married to one Kanta and their marriage was solemnized eight years ago.
Kanta committed suicide along with her two years daughter on railway track
and the complainant is the brother of Kanta. He further states that since the
marriage, there is no complaint against the petitioner whatsoever filed by
Kanta or his in-laws and there is no suicide note in the present case. The
petitioner is in custody since 19.08.2019.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sukhdeep Singh Parmar, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on
behalf of the respondent-State.

On instructions from Inspector Pardeep, learned State counsel
has pointed out that the petitioner is in custody since 19.08.2019. The
charges were framed on 03.12.2019 but no witness has been examined.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

It is a case of no suicide note and the petitioner is in custody since 19.08.2019. The charges were framed on 03.12.2019 but no witness has been examined. Trial of the case would take time to conclude. Therefore, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits, lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
