The petitioners are arrayed amongst the accused in FIR No. 130 dated 16.04.2020 on the file of Police Station City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala, under Sections 323, 354, 354B, 188, 452, 506, 148 and 149, IPC. By way of this petition, they seek grant of anticipatory bail.

Mr. Sahil Puri, learned counsel for the petitioners, would inform this Court that an affidavit was furnished by the complainant herself stating to the effect that the petitioners had nothing to do with the commission of the offence and that their names may be removed from the FIR. That apart, the record reflects that the co-accused of the petitioners, viz. Jatinder Singh alias Shera, against whom the complainant continues to

maintain her allegations, has been granted anticipatory bail by this Court

vide order dated 01.06.2020 passed in CRM-M-13389-2020, titled *Jatinder Singh @ Shera v/s. State of Punjab*, subject to conditions.

Given the aforestated circumstances, the petitioners would also be entitled to similar relief.

The petition is accordingly allowed directing the release of the petitioners on bail in the event of their arrest in FIR No. 130 dated 16.04.2020 on the file of Police Station City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala, subject to their furnishing personal bonds for a sum of ₹10,000/- each along with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioners shall also abide by the conditions specified in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
