Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner, as he is having some threat perception at the hands of respondents No.4 & 5.

It is stated in the petition that one Surjit Singh died on 25.09.1997 and thereafter, respondents No.4 & 5 had filed some forged documents claiming respondent No.5 to be one of the legal heir of Surjit Singh, whereas he is not legal heir. It is further stated that some other documents were also produced before the revenue authorities for the purpose of getting the mutation sanctioned and the petitioner had filed a civil suit for possession challenging the inheritance of Surjit Singh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had given a complaint dated 15.12.2018 (Annexure P-5) and another complaint dated 12.02.2019, but no action has been taken.

Learned State counsel, on the basis of reply by way of affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of Police, Industrial Area-A, Ludhiana, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3, has submitted that first representation dated 29.01.2019 was inquired into and after conducting the inquiry, it was filed, as no substance was found in the same.

Separate reply on behalf of respondents No.4 & 5, filed in the Court today, is taken on record, in which it is stated that respondents No.4 & 5 are in possession of the disputed house, on the basis of agreement/settlement dated 28.02.1991 and the matter is subjudice before the Civil Court.

In view of the above, no further action is called for, in the present petition and the same is disposed of.
