Instant contempt petition has been filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Court's Act, 1971 for willful and deliberate disobedience of the order dated 30.09.2019 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court in ***CWP No.28231 of 2019*** titled as ***Somnath vs. State of UT, Chandigarh and others.***

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that vide order dated 30.09.2019 this Court had directed the respondents to decide the representation of the petitioner by passing a speaking/detailed order within a period of four weeks and meanwhile, the eviction of the petitioner had been stayed. Learned counsel further alleges that despite a period of ten months having elapsed, the respondents have failed to take any decision on the representation filed by the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Deepali Puri, Addl. AG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents. Copy of paper book has already been supplied to her.

Learned State counsel submits that as per the instructions received by her, appropriate speaking order would be passed within a period of three weeks from today and would be immediately communicated to the petitioner as well.

Learned counsel for the petitioner in the wake of the statement made by learned counsel for the State, submits that he would not press the instant petition and the same may be disposed of as such.

Accordingly, the present petition stands disposed of as not pressed. It is made clear that the respondents shall be bound by the statement made by learned counsel for the State in the Court today.
