1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of pandemic Covid-19.
2. Learned counsel contends that the petitioner has filed petition under Section 23 of the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007 (for short 'the Act') against respondent Nos.4 and 5 through respondent No.6 for setting aside instrument No.11137 dated 21.03.2016 executed in favour of respondent Nos.4 and 5 to the extent of 2/3rd share in respect of House No.B-13/327, ID No.SRS/B13/783/21A constructed in Khewat No.593, Khatauni No.770, Muraba No.88, Killa No.10(3-15), along with constructed house but the same has not been decided till date despite the lapse of close to two years.
3. Learned counsel states that the petitioner would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of at this stage by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the petition (Annexure P-6) under the Act in a time bound manner.
4. Without commenting upon the merits of the controversy, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide

expeditiously as possible.

5. Writ petition disposed of with the aforementioned directions.
