This application has been filed by the petitioner for placing on record the orders, Annexure P-7 and P-8 passed by this Court in CRM-M No.32914 of 2012 whereby, 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> FIR which have been mentioned in the order dated 17.07.2020, have been quashed by this Court. Application is allowed.

Annexures P-7 and P-8 are taken on record.

**Main case**

Through the instant petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.151, dated 20.05.2020 registered under Sections 452, 324, 323, 148, 149, 427, 379-B and 411 of the IPC, 1860 at Police Station City, District Hoshiarpur.

Vide order dated 17.07.2020 passed by this Court, the petitioner was released on interim bail and was directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Pritpal Singh states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the said facts, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 17.07.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
