GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of the restrictions due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioner-Karamjit Singh, stated to be aged 32 years, has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.40 dated 25.06.2008, registered under Sections 379, 382, 411 & 34 of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Behram, District Nawanshahr (SBS Nagar).

Vide order dated 01.07.2020, the petitioner was granted interim bail and directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Amrik Singh states that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. The order dated 01.07.2020 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr. P.C.
